Welcome back everyone. We hope you and your families have enjoyed the school holidays and feel refreshed. We move into a busy final term of the year, with a number of activities organised and key learning to achieve.

#### Energy Efficiency and Sustainability

Over the holidays we had our old solar system dismantled and had the system upgraded. We now have 96 solar panels on the roof of our gym, which will feed through to the whole school.

We have also recently automated our electricity, so that most of our electricity is turned off on a timer basis. This will save us on our electricity bills in the future, so that we do not have electrical items on standby or on charge unnecessarily.



#### School Oval

Being in the wetlands area our school oval was flooded and soggy for a number of weeks during the winter months. Over the holidays we had our oval top dressed to get it in the best condition we can for the summer and the cricket season ahead.

#### Teachers' Games

Over the school holidays a group of Aspendale Gardens PS staff attended the Victorian Teacher Games. These games give education staff the opportunity to connect with other schools as well as enjoy some friendly competition. The staff had a fantastic time and were successful in achieving a Gold Medal in Softball, Silver Medal in Laser Skirmish and a Bronze Medal in Trivia.





#### **Student Absences**

We are now getting back into a settled routine, where there have not been any COVID cases within our school for a number of weeks. The teachers have hand sanitizer available in the classrooms and all the rooms have air purifiers in them. School attendance is very important for our students to feel comfortable and for the maximum learning to take place.

If, however your child is sick and cannot attend school we ask that you phone through to the office or complete the absence notification on Compass yourself. It is important that a reason for absence is included. Sending a Dojo message to the class teacher is useful to make the class teacher aware, but this needs to be in addition to marking it on Compass.

We ask all parents to log in to their Compass accounts to check for any unexplained absences and then update the absence with a reason e.g. Medical Appointment. Thank you for your support with this.

#### Parent Survey Results

Thank you to the parents who completed our annual parent / caregiver / guardian survey. We appreciate the time you took to give us your feedback. It was encouraging to look through the results and identify the areas that we are doing well in and the improvement we have made in our percentages from last year.

#### Some highlights from the results include:

An increase in the area of parent / caregiver / guardian participation and involvement from 78% to 86% An increase in parents' 'general satisfaction' from 81% to 90%

An increase in the category of school improvement from 66% to 75%

An increase in the area of high expectations for success from 81% to 88%

#### The areas that we continue to discuss and look for ways to improve on include:

Teachers communicating with parents about their child's progress.

The parents having a clear understanding of the school's strengths and areas for improvement.

An understanding of how their child is assessed.

#### Year 3 Camp – Mount Evelyn

The Year 3s will be going off to camp next week at the fun YMCA Camp at Mount Evelyn. This is an excellent introductory camp for the students, where they will experience a greater level of independence and achievement in some new activities and challenges. We wish all the students and staff a fantastic time away.

#### **Assemblies**

Beginning in Week 2, we would like to welcome our parents / grandparents back to our assemblies. We ask our visitors not to arrive before 2.30pm and to sign in at the school office on arrival. Our assemblies usually commence at 2.40pm by the time all of our students have walked over to the gym after the lunch break. We look forward to seeing some of you at next week's assembly.

#### **Marine Ambassador Peer Teaching Workshops**

Throughout 2022 our four Year 6 Environmental Leaders/Marine Ambassadors attended a number of *i sea i care* workshops, along with the environmental leaders from other primary schools in the local area. They learnt about caring for our bays, oceans and waterways and engaged with a range of activities that aim to build their knowledge in this area. The Term 1 workshop was centred around setting the students up with the skills and knowledge to run a peer teaching workshop back at our school for students in the younger year levels. Due to Covid restrictions, our ambassadors were not able to share these experiences with other year levels earlier in the year, but they have finally been able to do so.

During Term 3 Hazel, Ben, Georgie and Sarah spent many lunchtimes researching, creating resources, planning for and practising their workshops in preparation for the final week of the term, and their opportunity to shine! Three foundation classes kindly volunteered an hour out of their week to invite the ambassadors into their classrooms to run the workshops and all feedback suggests they were a hit!

Themes that were a focus for these sessions included:

- Identifying marine life and objects that may be found in our waterways (including kelp holdfasts, shells, sea sponges and plastic bottles) and why they are found where they are.
- The importance of looking after all waterways and sea life including Leatherback sea turtles, sea otters, Crown of Thorns starfish and baby sea lions.
- How litter and foreign objects make their way to our oceans and bays, the effects it can have on sea life and how to reduce water pollution and it's impacts.

The workshops were run solely by our AGPS environmental leaders and the manner in which they engaged, interacted with and shared their knowledge with the foundation students was fantastic. We would like to send a big thank you to FCH, FNA and FMC students and staff for allowing the Year 6 students to put their environmental learning into practice, as the workshops were a valuable learning experience for all involved. Well done to our wonderful Environmental Leaders/Marine Ambassadors for their dedication and hard work this year!




