



Herb and Cheese Scones

Season: Autumn Type: Side

Serves: 30 tastings

From the garden: Rosemary

Class focus: Rubbing the butter into the flour



Equipment: Ingredients: Large mixing bowl x 1 5 cups self-raising flour

Wooden spoon x 1 Measuring cups Measuring spoons

Chopping boards and knives

Baking paper Baking tray x 2 Serving plate x 5 Kitchen tong x 5

1 tablespoon sugar 125g butter (cubed -2cm)

1 cup grated cheese

1 teaspoon salt

4 sprigs rosemary (leaves only, finely chopped)

500ml milk

What to do:

- 1. Heat oven to 180C.
- 2. Wash the herb.
- 3. Prepare all of the ingredients based on the instructions in the ingredients list.
- 4. Put the <u>first 4 ingredients</u> in a large mixing bowl, rub in with fingers until it looks like crumbs.
- 5. Stir in the <u>next 2 ingredients</u>.
- 6. Then add the milk.
- 7. Stir with a wooden spoon until mixture starting to come together.
- 8. Pour the dough onto lightly floured bench and gently knead it slightly.
- 9. Divide dough into 6 portions.
- 10. Using your hands, flatten and shape each dough into a square and about 2 cm thick.
- 11. Cut each dough into 5 squares and place on lined baking trays.
- 12. You should get 30 square scones in total.
- 13. Bake for 12 minutes or until lightly browned.
- 14. Serve into 5 large serving plates with a kitchen tong in each.
