Children may take their recorders home for Christmas holidays but must remember to bring them back first day next year. Please re-label with their new class name and room number.



I am so excited to be back at AGPS this year.


Make sure you are going to bed on time, using your manners and are being kind. Each day I will return to a new hiding spot.

If you can't remember if you have already paid, please phone the office on 9587 0877 and the lovely office ladies will be able to help you.


