We had an excellent response from parents regarding the Parent Remote Learning survey sent out half way through remote learning. A follow up survey for the completion of remote learning was sent out yesterday. It would be wonderful if you could fill it in and send it back. It is very short and will be very quick to complete.

Secondary School Transitions.

Our Year 6 students have been allocated their places in secondary schools and we heard this week that the State-wide Orientation Day will be occurring later on in the term. We understand that this is a time where students are sometimes anxious about the change and have questions to be answered. Our Year 6 teachers are spending time having valuable conversations about the transition and preparing the students in the best way possible.



In Week 8, the students will experience a mock Year 7 week, where they will have the experience of following a timetable and moving between rooms and teachers and having Year 7 types of lessons. Behind the scenes our Year 6 teachers have been passing on important information to our secondary schools. For some schools, this has meant our teachers completing spreadsheets, for other schools they have had WebEx meetings to pass on information. This is an important part of our transition process, so that the secondary schools have the necessary information to support the students academically, socially and emotionally. This communication between AGPS and our secondary schools will continue on this term and into 2022.

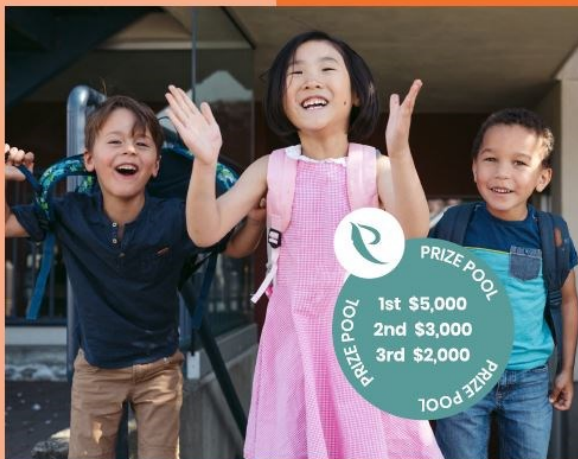

Hello from the TheirCare team at Aspendale Gardens!

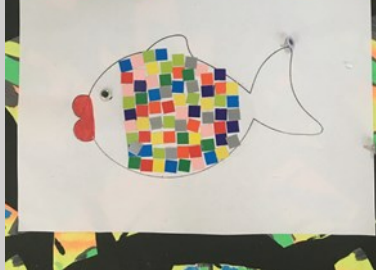
We have welcomed back a few more children here at TheirCare and are looking forward to seeing all of the children return next week!

HALLOWEEN!

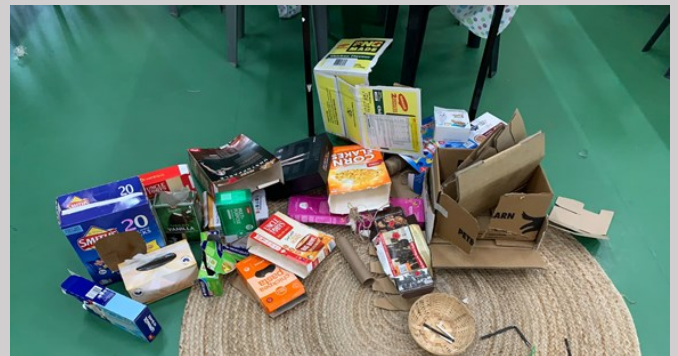

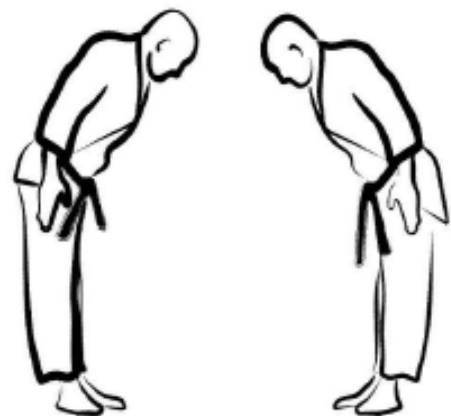
